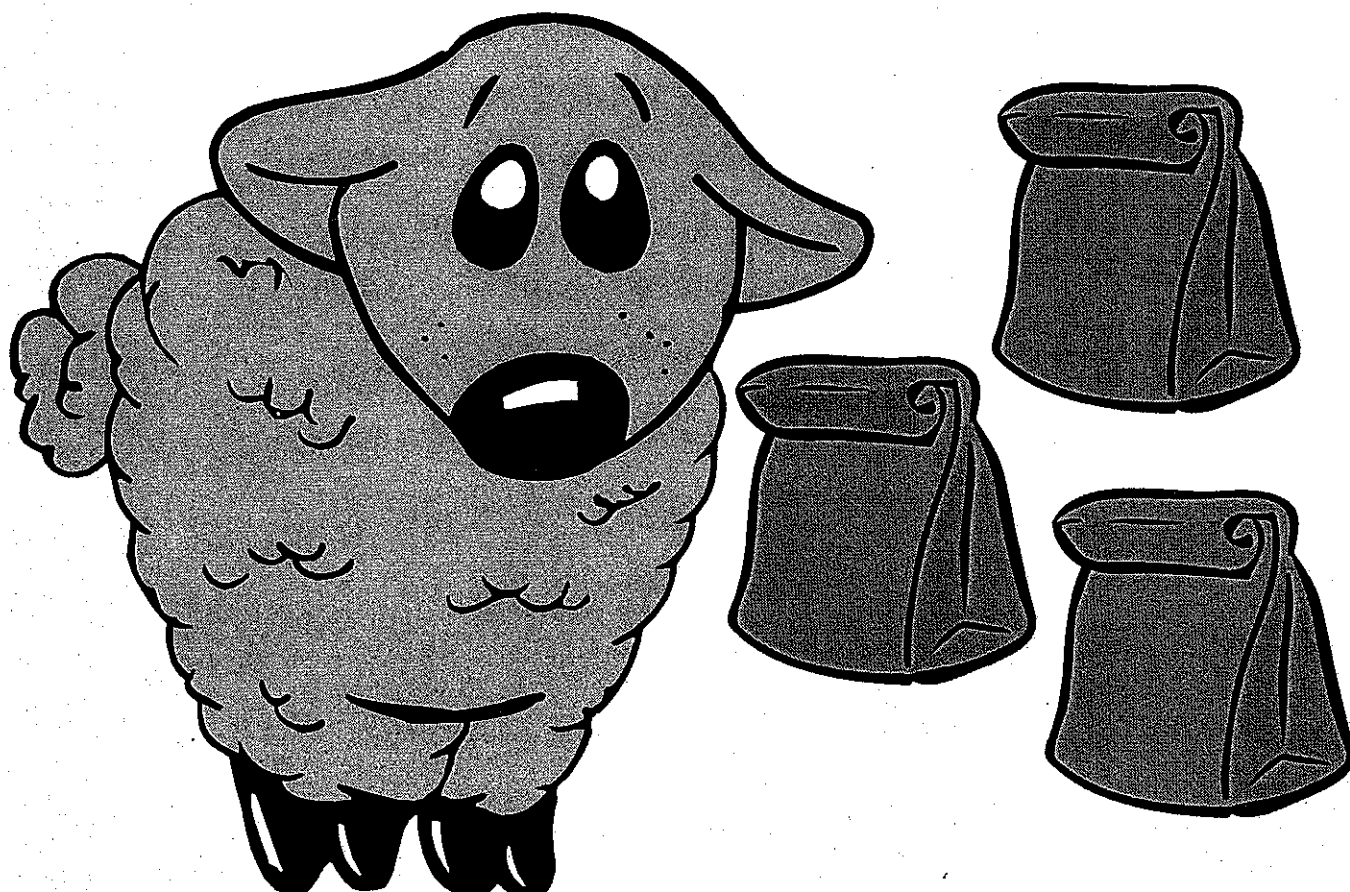

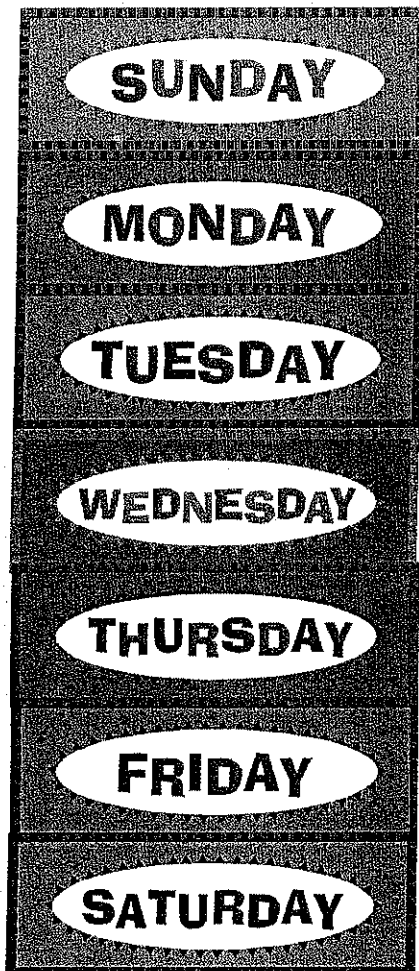

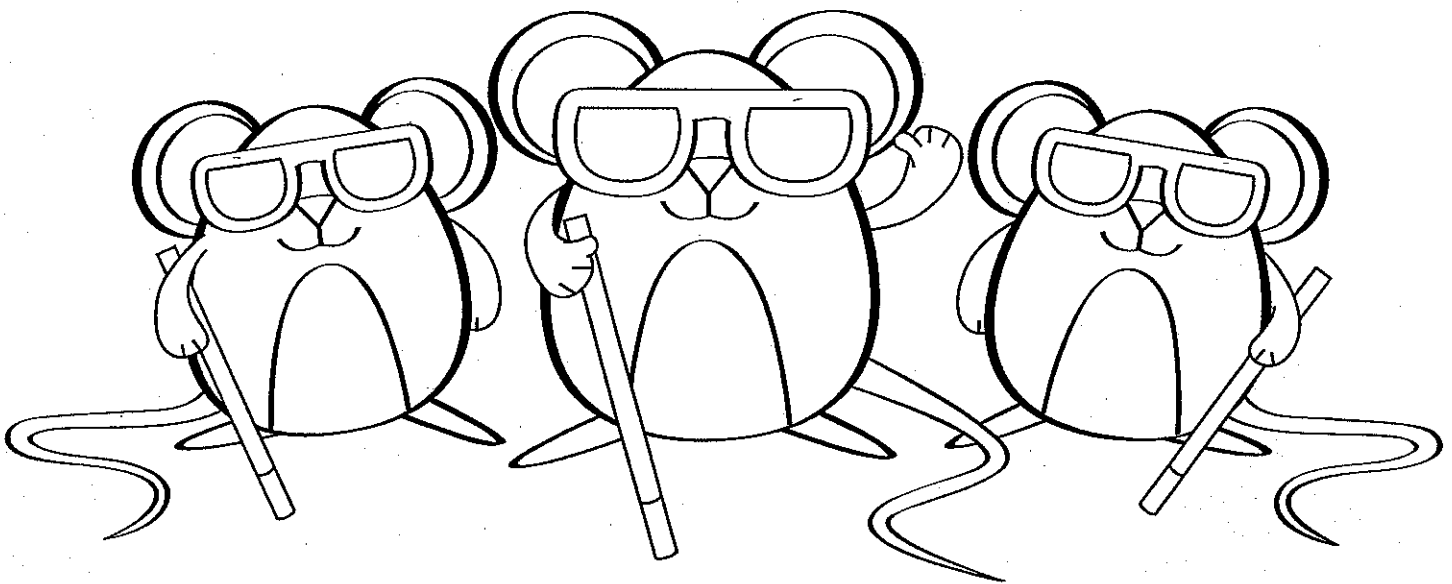

Only a ribbon around it.

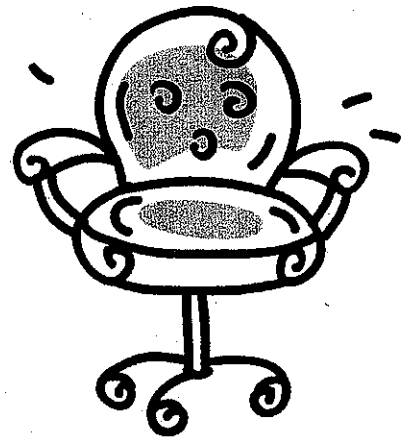

Anna Elise, she jumped with surprise

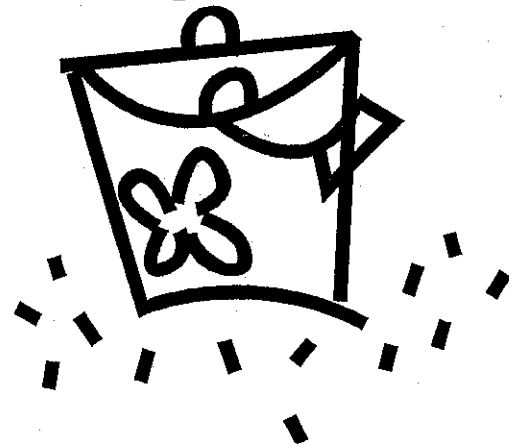
